| Holter Monitor 24 or 48 <br> Hours | Bring a written list of all your current <br> medications. <br> Do not apply creams or lotions to your chest <br> area the day of the test. <br> Five leads will be applied to your chest. Men <br> with chest hair may have to be shaved in small <br> areas. <br> The technologist will arrange a return time with <br> you. <br> Holter Monitor is due back at the Hospital the <br> day it is removed. | Stress Test | Wear or bring comfortable shoes for walking - <br> no high heels or heavy boots. <br> Avoid exhausting activity the day of your test. <br> Do not apply creams or lotions to your chest <br> area the day of your test. <br> Men with chest hair may need to be shaved in <br> small areas. | 40 Minutes |
