Brant Community Healthcare System (BCHS) is a 300+ bed acute care facility boasting stable, state-of-the-art Programs within a team environment and with a dedicated staff that ensures high-level, patient-focused care. The organization comprises of two main hospital sites, the Brantford General Hospital and Willett Hospital. Located in the picturesque Grand River Valley 20 minutes west of Hamilton, our community offers outstanding recreational opportunities.

BCHS is the area's acute care facility, providing all of Brantford and Brant County's specialty programs and services for our 120,000+ residents. We are the regional center for a number of services including pediatrics, mental health, obstetrics and gynaecology, critical care, surgery, and emergency medicine. We are also the District Stroke Centre for Brant, Haldimand and Norfolk regions. BCHS is a satellite site of the Hamilton Regional Cancer Centre providing an onsite daily cancer clinic along with a dialysis unit as a part of the St. Joseph's Healthcare Hamilton hemodialysis program.

We are recruiting for a full time radiologist to join our group of 9 radiologists. The department performs over 150,000 exams per year with anticipated growth to over 170,000 exams by the end of the year.

The successful candidate will be supporting the expansion and augmentation of existing IR procedures within the organization, including abscess drainage, visceral and lung biopsies, as well as percutaneous urologic procedures. This physician will be rotating through the DI services of X-ray, CT, ultrasound and MRI. This position does not include nuclear medicine reporting. The position includes equitable weekend and week day coverage along with the occasional overnight call (approximately one night every two months).

Interested physicians must have an independent practice license from the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario and a Royal College Fellowship in Radiology. Additional training in MSK US or diagnostic neuroimaging would be an asset. Excellent interpersonal skills and a commitment to an inter-professional care model are also essential.
