

Where Can I Access Health Care in Brantford/Brant County?



Call **911** or go to the **Emergency Department**

For symptoms that come on suddenly, such as:

- Unable to breathe
- Severe chest pain
- Stroke or stroke symptoms
- Passing out
- Choking
- Uncontrolled bleeding



Visit **The Willett Urgent Care Centre**

For symptoms such as:

- Coughs, colds, sore throats, ear infections
- Urinary tract infections (UTIs)
- Sprain, strains and other joint or muscle injuries
- Suspected fractures (unless the patient cannot ambulate)
- Mild to moderate asthma
- Rashes
- Other acute, non-emergent issues



Call or book online:
Primary Care Appointments with Physicians & Nurse Practitioners

To book an appointment for:

- Chronic conditions
- Screening
- Routine tests
- Bloodwork

*This also includes same day or next day appointments for any of the minor symptoms mentioned under the Willett Urgent Care Centre
